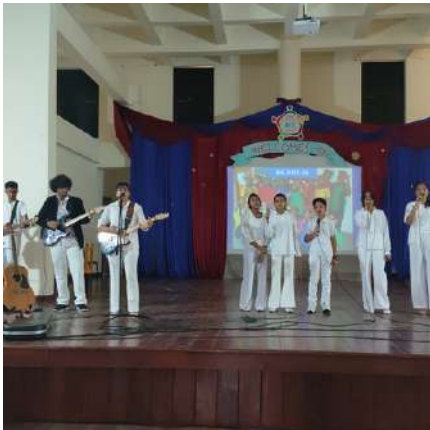
The assembly concluded with a powerful message encouraging everyone to support one another and prioritise mental health.

The event was both enjoyable and enriching, encouraging students to appreciate traditional games while promoting team spirit, physical fitness, and active participation.



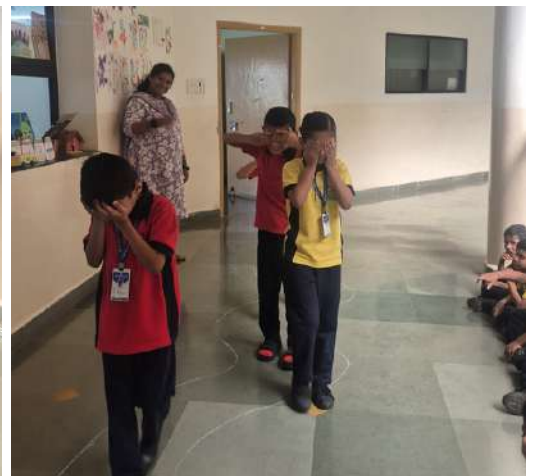
4. Innovative Vibes

"Where Voices United and Community Spirit Flourished."

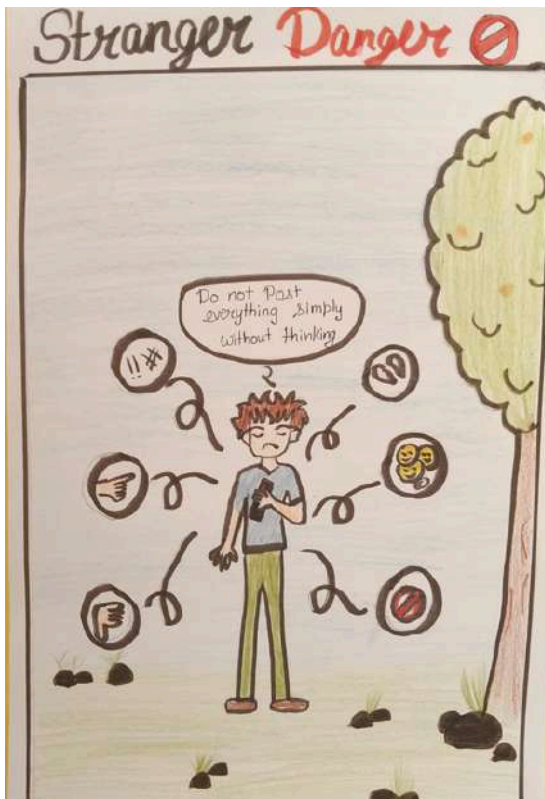
